Car seats for people with disabilities and medical conditions

All people have the right to travel safely and comfortably

Australian standard car seats

- Suitable for children from birth up to 10-12 years of age
- Comply with the Australian/New Zealand Standard 1754
- · Available from retail shops and online (low cost)
- Independently crash tested, visit www.childcarseats.com.au
- Products available with built-in harness suitable for 50% of children 10 years old
- Support with installation from child restraint fitters
- No medical certificate required
- MACA's <u>national product register</u> includes a list of car seats more commonly used by children with disabilities and medical conditions



Special purpose car seats

- Suitable for children (and older people) from birth to 80 kilos
- · Comply with overseas standards and regulations
- Require assessment by trained health professionals (e.g., occupational therapist)
- Independently crash tested by the <u>Australian</u> <u>Safety Assessment Program</u> — view tested products on MACA's <u>national product register</u>.
- Offer features not available with Australian standard car seats, such as:
 - Additional postural support
 - Extra recline and tilt in space
 - Footrests
 - Anti-escape options
 - Swivel base
- Higher cost and can be delays in access (e.g., NDIS approval)
- Support with installation from Disability Product Suppliers
- Medical certificate and/or Advice to Parent form required for use (depends on state or territory requirements)
